There is an invitation to act for our migrant brothers and sisters. This could be done by volunteering or supporting agencies that are of direct service or by supporting officials who are establishing "sanctuary" cities and states. It might be a call to be an activist for the planet. Above all, there is an underlying need for a change in the way our political structures are functioning. It is important that we find ways to remove "dark money" from our system, that voting rights be protected and fair representation be guaranteed. Groups like the League of Women Voters and Common Cause are working in these areas. It is challenging work, but absolutely necessary. Consider ways in which you can be active.
