... to our sisters at the St. Agnes Home community on the death of our sister, Ursula McGann, who died on June 27, 2018.


Social Justice Notes

The US senate passed its version of the Farm Bill. This version does not include the punitive and restrictive changes to the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (food stamps). The two bills must now be reconciled in conference committee. Please contact both your senators and representatives and encourage support of the senate bill (it is a bipartisan bill).

LCWR encourages continued action to end family separation in our immigration practices. Please consider how you can best support efforts to re-unite families and end the criminalization of persons seeking refugee or asylee status. LCWR has also spoken out in defense of our Moslem brothers and sisters and against discrimination against them solely because of their places of birth.

Once again, the horror of mass shootings is brought before us. The website <u>www.everytown.org</u> has information on ways to end this horror.

The <u>Catholic Climate Covenant</u> has information on ways in which we can continue responding to the call of *Laudato Si*. There are many local, regional and national actions that can have an impact.
